## Marvel Two-in-One: 51 Dancing Dolphin Patterns from 1974-1983

Marvel Two-in-One was a comic book series published by Marvel Comics from 1974 to 1983. The series featured the adventures of the Thing and various other Marvel superheroes. The covers of the series were often adorned with a dancing dolphin, and over the years, 51 different dolphin designs were used.

The dancing dolphin motif was first introduced on the cover of Marvel Twoin-One #1, which was released in January 1974. The dolphin was drawn by artist John Buscema, and it was intended to be a symbol of the Thing's carefree and optimistic nature. The dolphin quickly became a popular symbol with readers, and it was soon adopted as the official logo of the Marvel Two-in-One series.

Over the years, the dancing dolphin logo underwent several changes. The most notable change occurred in 1979, when the dolphin was redesigned by artist George Perez. Perez's dolphin was more stylized and streamlined

than Buscema's original design, and it has remained the standard dolphin logo ever since.

In addition to the main dancing dolphin logo, Marvel Two-in-One also featured a number of other dolphin designs on its covers. These designs were often used to promote specific storylines or events in the series. For example, the cover of Marvel Two-in-One #50 featured a dolphin wearing a Santa Claus hat, to promote the series' Christmas special.

The dancing dolphin logo is one of the most iconic symbols in Marvel Comics history. It is a symbol of the Thing's enduring popularity, and it represents the spirit of adventure and optimism that has always been at the heart of the Marvel Two-in-One series.




