8. Using black yarn, stitch a French knot for the mouth.
9. Using orange yarn, create two half circles for the wings.
10. Attach the wings to the back of the bat.

Assembling the Box

12. Cut five pieces of plastic canvas to measure 10 holes wide by 3 holes high.
13. Single crochet around the perimeter of each piece, using black yarn.

14. Join the pieces together to form the sides and bottom of the box.
15. Attach the bat design to the front of the box.
16. Add a small piece of ribbon to the top of the box for decoration.

Tips for Success

- Use a tapestry needle for precision when stitching on plastic canvas.
- Don't be afraid to experiment with different yarn colors and patterns.
- Add additional embellishments, such as sequins or beads, for a touch of sparkle.
- Use the keepsake box for storing small items like jewelry, candies, or Halloween keepsakes.
- Make multiple boxes to create a set of spooky storage solutions.

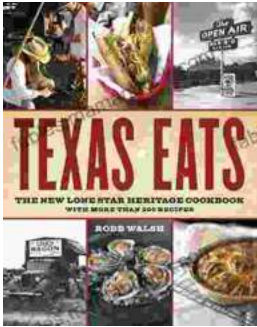

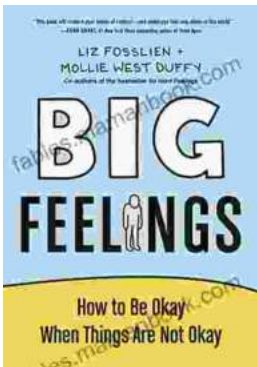
